The meeting will begin at **6:30 p.m.** with the third section called **Business Items**. The business items section contains items for approval by the District Board of Supervisors that may require discussion, motion and votes on an item-by-item basis. If any member of the audience would like to speak on one of the business items, they will need to register with the District Administrator prior to the presentation of that agenda item. The fourth section is called **Consent Agenda**. The Consent Agenda section contains items that require the review and approval of the District Board of Supervisors as a normal course of business. The fifth section is called **Vendor/Staff Reports**. This section allows the District Administrator, Engineer, and Attorney to update the Board of Supervisors on any pending issues that are being researched for Board action.

The final section is called **Supervisor Requests and Audience Comments**. This is the section in which the Supervisors may request Staff to prepare certain items in an effort to meet residential needs. The Audience Comment portion of the agenda is where individuals may comment on matters that concern the District. Each individual is limited to **three (3) minutes** for such comment. The Board of Supervisors or Staff is not obligated to provide a response until sufficient time for research or action is warranted. IF THE COMMENT CONCERNS A MAINTENANCE RELATED ITEM, THE ITEM WILL NEED TO BE ADDRESSED BY THE DISTRICT ADMINSTRATOR OUTSIDE THE CONTEXT OF THIS MEETING.

Agendas can be reviewed by contacting the Manager's office at (813) 873-7300 at least seven days in advance of the scheduled meeting. Requests to place items on the agenda must be submitted in writing with an explanation to the District Manager at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the meeting.

Public workshops sessions may be advertised and held in an effort to provide informational services. These sessions allow staff or consultants to discuss a policy or business matter in a more informal manner and allow for lengthy presentations prior to scheduling the item for approval. Typically, no motions or votes are made during these sessions.

Pursuant to provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act, any person requiring special accommodations to participate in this meeting is asked to advise the District Office at (813) 873-7300, at least 48 hours before the meeting. If you are hearing or speech impaired, please contact the Florida Relay Service at 1 (800) 955-8770, who can aid you in contacting the District Office.

PROPOSAL/AGREEMENT

CUSTOMER

Northwood of Pasco 27248 Big Sur Dr Wesley Chapel, FL 33544

Agreement made between Sports Surfaces LLC hereinafter called the Contractor, and Northwood of Pasco, hereinafter called the Customer, for the resurfacing of a full tennis and full basketball court with respect to the following terms and specifications.

TENNIS / BASKETBALL / FUTSAL EQUIPMENT:

The Contractor will remove one existing basketball system and dispose of off-site.

The Contractor will supply and install (1) new RuffNeck Extreme fixed height "Gooseneck" basketball system with

36" x 60" steel backboard mounted on 4 ½" sch 40 galvanized steel posts buried 48" below grade set in concrete.

The Contractor will supply and install (1) Kwik Goal futsal goal system: 6'7" Height x 9'10" Width x 3'7 1/2" Base 3.15" x 3.15" square front post and crossbar with powder coated white finish.

The Contractor will install (1) pair of new 2 7/8" OD powder coated steel tennis net posts set in existing sleeves.

The Contractor will supply and install (1) new Edwards 30LS tennis net.









TENNIS / BASKETBALL / FUTSAL COURT PREPARATION:

The Contractor will pressure clean and power blow court as necessary to remove loose dirt, mildew and oil.

The Contractor will locate and mark depressions holding water greater than 1/16" after 1 hour drying time in direct sunlight.

The Contractor will clean and fill depressions using acrylic patch binder.

The Contractor will clean and fill asphalt cracks using acrylic crack filler prior to surfacing.

Note: court must have a minimum of 1% slope in one plane to guarantee removal of water.

BASKETBAL / FUTSAL COURT FENCE:

The Contractor will supply and install 50 LF of 6' 9 gauge vinyl coated chain link fence as a divider between the sports.

TENNIS / BASKETBALL / FUTSAL COURT SURFACING and STRIPING:

The Contractor will apply (2) Coat of Acrylic Resurfacer over entire court area to fill voids and provide a uniform surface.

The Contractor will apply (2) Coats of Acrylic Color (two-tone) to provide in depth color and texture to the court surface.

Tennis: Inner court color choice BLUE Outer court color choice LIGHT GREEN

Basketball: Overall court color choice <u>LIGHT GREEN</u> Key color choice <u>BLUE</u>

Futsal: Overall court color choice <u>LIGHT GREEN</u> Penalty area color choice <u>BLUE</u>

The Contractor will accurately locate and mark playing lines on the court surface.

The Contractor will apply striping tape using taping machine for pinpoint accuracy.

The Contractor will seal the tape to eliminate bleeding of line paint onto the court surface outside of the playing lines.

The Contractor will paint 2" wide tennis playing lines with 3" wide base lines in accordance with USTA regulation.

The Contractor will paint 2" wide basketball playing lines in accordance with high school half court regulations.

The Contractor will paint 2" wide futsal playing lines in accordance with FIFA half court regulations.

The Contractor shall thoroughly and expediently clean up all drums, trash, etc. upon job completion.

GUARANTEE:

The Contractor guarantees all work against defects in workmanship or materials for a period of (2) years from date of completion. This guarantee excludes Normal wear and tear, physical abuse or neglect and any other conditions beyond the contractor's control, such as subbase settling, cracks, hydrostatic pressure or water vapor pressure bubbles, intrusion of weeds or grass, etc. Existing cracks may reappear at any time. Proper tennis shoes must be worn on court. Some sneakers, street shoes, dark soled shoes, skateboards, roller blades, etc. will scuff and damage surface. Guarantee shall become void upon owner's failure to adhere and comply with the payment schedule.

CONDITIONS:

The Customer will furnish stable access to site for equipment and material and provide a clean water supply and electrical feed at job site within 100' for construction use. The owner shall be responsible for seeing that all landscaping, grass, and shrubs outside the court perimeter be lower than the court surface to aid in proper drainage.

Unless otherwise specified, repair of root damaged asphalt is not included. Should our field technician discover such asphalt damage, repairs will be authorized by the customer prior to the commencement of repair work. The Contractor accepts no responsibility for acts by anyone at job site except for those sub-contracted or employed by Sports Surfaces LLC. The Customer shall keep all sprinkler systems off during resurfacing work and for 1 day following the completion of work. Damages due to sprinkler system are billed as an additional expense to owner.

PROVISIONS:

The Customer agrees to pay a 33% deposit upon acceptance of proposal.

The Customer agrees to pay a 33% deposit upon commencement.

The Customer agrees to pay balance upon completion of the above-proposed work.

CREDIT:

If the Customer does not pay as agreed upon, the Contractor shall have the right to file a lien against the real estate in the amount of the work done. No further work shall be accomplished if installment payments are not made at the time specified.

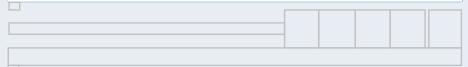

Understanding Your Electric Charges

Average kWh per day – The average amount of electricity purchased per day.

Basic Service Charge - A fixed monthly amount that covers the cost to provide service to your location.

Bright Choices—The number of leased light fixtures and/or poles and associated fees and charges.

Budget Billing - Optional plan averages your home's last 12 monthly billing periods so you pay the same amount for your service each month.

Energy Charge - The cost (except fuel) of producing and delivering the electricity you purchased, including conservation, environmental and capacity cost recovery charges.

Estimated ~ If Tarnpa Electric was unable to read your meter, "ESTIMATED" will appear. Your meter will be read next month, and any difference will be adjusted accordingly.

Florida Gross Receipts Tax — A tax is imposed on gross receipts from utility services that are delivered to retail customers in Florida, in accordance with Chapter 203 of the Florida Statutes. Utility companies collect the tax from all customers, unless exempt, and remit to the state.

Florida State Tax - A tax imposed on every person who engages in the business of selling or renting tangible personal property at retail in the state, in accordance with Chapter 212 of the Florida Statutes.

Franchise Fee – A fee levied by a municipality for the right to utilize public property to provide electric service. The fee is collected by Tampa Electric and paid to the municipality.

Fuel Charge – Cost of fuel used to produce electricity you purchased. Fuel costs are passed through from fuel suppliers to our customers with no markup or profit to Tampa Electric.

Kilowatt-Hours (kWh) - The basic measurement of electric energy use.

Late Payment Charge – For past due amounts more than \$10, the late payment charge is the greater of \$5 or 1.5% of the past due amount. For past due amounts of \$10 or less, the late payment charge is 1.5% of the past due amount.

Municipal Public Service Tax – Many municipalities levy a tax on the electricity you use. It is collected by Tampa Electric and paid to the municipality.

Past Due – Previous charges that are past due are subject to a late payment charge fee and may result in disconnection.

Rate Schedule – The amount (rate) you pay depends on your customer category. The cost of providing service varies with the customer group.

Share – A program co-sponsored by Tampa Electric and the Salvation Army for customers to help pay the energy bills of customers in need one time or monthly on your bill. Your contribution is tax deductible and is matched by Tampa Electric.

Sun Select™ - The cost of producing energy you purchased from dedicated solar generation facilities. You pay no fuel charge for the Sun Select portion of your bill.

Sun to Go* - The amount of electricity purchased from solar generating sources serving the Sun to Go program, which provides optional renewable energy purchases in 200 kWh blocks.

Total Amount Due – This month's charges will be past due after the date shown. THIS DATE DOES NOT EXTEND THE DATE ON ANY PREVIOUS BALANCE. It's important that you pay your bill before this date to avoid interruption of service.

Zap Cap Systems* - Surge protection for your home or business sold separately as a non-energy charge.

- 12. Prune sucker growth up to 15 feet from frontage Oak trees.
- 13. Contractor is reminded to bag and remove Ganoderma conks from old palm trunks when and where found.
- 14. Thoroughly remove windfall and debris from Philodendron beds during weekly service visits.
- 15. Near Carlyle village monument: Prune downward growth from roadside Oak trees.

- 17. Prune Philodendron off bed lines. Avoid over-pruning Philodendrons, maintaining a low, mounded form.

Management Summary

Throughout the September inspection of the waterways of the Northwood CDD community, the following observations were made:

- Site #4 experienced filamentous algae growth at a 3-5 foot perimeter band, and an accumulation within the wind blown cove of the waterway.
- Regrowth of shoreline grasses were observed in small quantities within site #5.
- Filamentous algae was present throughout the littoral shelf of site #6, and around the perimeter of the site at a 2-3 foot band.
- Site #7 looked great during this inspection, and exhibited evidence of a recent shoreline grass treatment.
- Site #13 had shoreline grasses around the perimeter of the waterway, and Hydrilla, an invasive submersed weed, throughout the site.
- Filamentous algae growth was present atop of Chara and Slender Spikerush, submersed growth, at approximately 50% of the surface area of site #14. Regrowth of shoreline grasses was also observed.
- Site #17 experienced Primrose Willow and Torpedo Grass growth around the shoreline.
- Site #19 had excess grass clippings within the site which can fuel algal growth. Evidence of a recent shoreline grass treatment was also observed.
- Site #20 had remained dry during this inspection, and a recent grass treatment was evident.
- Filamentous algae was observed atop of Slender Spikerush, a nuisance submersed weed, that had reached the surface of site #28.

Recommendations/Action Items

Aquatic Systems, Inc. will focus on the following during our upcoming scheduled visits:

- Administer algae treatments within sites 4, 6, 14, and 28 targeting the filamentous growth present.
- Apply shoreline grass treatments for the undesired vegetation at sites 5, 13, 14, and 17.
- Perform submersed weed treatments for the submersed growth within sites 13, 14, and 28.
- Monitor the decomposition of all previously targeted growth.
- Closely monitor site #7 for new undesired growth, targeting as observed to maintain current desired conditions.
- Continue to clear debris from all sites.
- Follow up with all previous treatments to ensure that desired conditions are achieved and maintained.
