The meeting will begin at 6:30 p.m. Following the Call to Order, the public has the opportunity to comment on posted agenda items during the third section called Audience Questions and Comments on Agenda Items. Each individual is limited to three (3) minutes for such comment. The Board is not required to take action at this time, but will consider the comments presented as the agenda progresses. Following public comment, the meeting will proceed with the fourth section called Vendor and Staff Reports. This section will allow Vendors and District Engineer and Attorney to update Board on work and to present proposals. The fifth section is called Business Items. This section contains items for approval by the District Board of Supervisors that may require discussion, motions, and votes on an item-by-item basis. The sixth section is called Consent Agenda. The Consent Agenda section contains items that require the review and approval of the District Board of Supervisors as a normal course of business. The seventh section will be Management Reports. This section allows the District Manager and Staff to update the Board of Supervisors on any pending issues that are being researched for Board action. Occasionally, certain items for decision within this section are required by Florida Statute to be held as a Public Hearing. In the event of a Public Hearing, each member of the public will be permitted to provide one comment on the issue, prior to the Board of Supervisors' discussion, motion, and vote.

The eighth section is called **Supervisor Requests**. This is the section in which the Supervisors may request Staff to prepare certain items in an effort to meet the District's needs. The final section is called **Audience Questions**, **Comments and Discussion Forum**. This portion of the agenda is where individuals may comment on matters that concern the District. The Board of Supervisors or Staff is not obligated to provide a response until sufficient time for research or action is warranted.

Pursuant to provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act, any person requiring special accommodations to participate in this meeting is asked to advise the District Office at (813) 397-5120, at least 48 hours before the meeting. If you are hearing or speech impaired, please contact the Florida Relay Service at 1 (800) 955-8770, who can aid you in contacting the District Office.

Brian Mortillaro with LMP presented the Board with a proposal to fill in some of the empty areas along the wall. Supervisor Uhlig said she thought they would just do bushes because it would be

cheaper. She also asked if the plantings in the proposal would be frost-tolerant, and Mr. Mortillaro said yes. Mr. Woods asked what types of plants were being suggested. Mr. Mortillaro went over what would do well in the area. Supervisor Uhlig asked about using wax myrtle trees. Mr. Mortillaro said they were trying to get rid of those types of trees. Mr. Woods said they don't really produce persistent color. Supervisor Cruz said this may be a good opportunity to take care of the area once and for all, and they want color.

Supervisor Uhlig asked when they had started keeping track of the types of plants installed. Mr. Mortillaro said in the summer. Supervisor Cruz asked what happened with this rotation. Mr. Woods said he would suggest aligning plantings with the nurseries, and February is early for the spring rotation. The winter rotation should be November through February, and the spring rotation should start in March. Mr. Woods provided the traditional color schemes and what is available. Supervisor Cruz said using that schedule, there would be about six weeks left in this rotation, and there are about 40% of the annuals dead. She asked if they should be replaced. Mr. Woods said they should have the contractor replace them under warranty.

Mr. Woods said that in March, they would go with the bouquet look with spring mix, as these handle the increasing heat. Supervisor Cruz talked about the flowers at a shopping center off of Dale Mabry in Carrollwood. She asked for Mr. Woods to stop by and take a look. Supervisor Cruz also talked about zero scape landscaping. Mr. Mortillaro said will bring annual suggestions for next month and will replace the flowers that failed due to irrigation.

Mr. Mortillaro brought up the proposal to remove the three dead pines. The Board discussed the proposal. Ms. Hicks said they shouldn't wait because they will lose more trees.

B. Discussion on Boulders

 Ms. Hicks gave brief update on what occurred with the boulders and that the CDD received a violation from the County because the boulders are in violation of the clear zone. Mr. Babbar said that with the current agreement with the County, the CDD is permitted to do certain landscaping improvements, but the area belongs to the county. Supervisor Cruz said the County hasn't maintained the area. Mr. Babbar said adverse possession doesn't apply to government property. Supervisor Kilpatrick said they do not want to expose the CDD to any liability. She said they should ask the County to provide the CDD with alternatives to stop speeding and prevent people from damaging the landscaping. Then, the CDD can move the boulders. Mr. Babbar said if they don't move the boulders, the County can take away the CDD's right to maintain the area and expose the CDD to liability.

The Board discussed sending a letter to the County expressing the issues and their concerns. Mr. Babbar said that his concern with drafting a letter on District Counsel's letterhead is that it may cause an escalation in the situation. The Board discussed and agreed that Counsel can write the letter and send to management for Board approval. Management will use the CDD's letterhead and send it to the County.

Mr. Babbar said his only other update is that he is monitoring the legislative cycle and will provide updates as necessary.

Understanding Your Electric Charges

Average kWh per day - The average amount of electricity purchased per day.

Basic Service Charge - A fixed monthly amount to cover the cost of providing service to your location.

Bright Choicessm - The number of light fixtures and/or poles leased from Tampa Electric, and associated fees and charges.

Budget Billing - Optional plan takes the highs and lows out of monthly electric bills. This "leveling" billing plan averages your last 12 monthly billing periods so you can pay about the same amount for your service each month.

Energy Charge – The cost (except fuel) of producing the electricity you purchased, including conservation, environmental and capacity cost recovery charges.

Estimated – If Tampa Electric was unable to read your meter, "ESTIMATED" will appear. Your electric use has been estimated based on previous usage. The meter is scheduled to be read next month, and any difference between the estimate and actual use will be adjusted accordingly.

Florida Gross Receipts Tax – A tax is imposed on gross receipts from utility services that are delivered to retail customers in Florida, in accordance with Chapter 203 of the Florida Statutes. The tax is levied on utility companies, which collect the tax from all customers, unless exempt, and remit to the state.

Florida State Tax – A privilege tax imposed on every person who engages in the business of selling or renting tangible personal property at retail in the state, in accordance with Chapter 212 of the Florida Statutes.

Franchise Fee - A fee levied by a municipality for the right to utilize public property for the purpose of providing electric service. Like taxes, the fee is collected by Tampa Electric and is paid to the municipality.

Fuel Charge – Cost of fuel used to produce electricity you purchased. Fuel costs are passed through from fuel suppliers to our customers with no markup or profit to Tampa Electric.

Kilowatt-Hours (kWh) - The basic measurement of electric energy use.

Late Payment Charge – For past due amounts more than \$10, the late payment charge is the greater of \$5 or 1.5% of the past due amount. For past due amounts of \$10 or less, the late payment charge is 1.5% of the past due amount.

Municipal Public Service Tax – In addition to the Franchise Fee, many municipalities levy a tax on the electricity you use. It is collected by Tampa Electric and paid to the municipality.

Past Due -- Previous charges that are past due are subject to a late payment charge fee and may result in disconnection.

Rate Schedule – The amount (rate) you pay depends on your customer category. The cost of providing service varies with the customer group.

Renewable Energy_{5M} - The amount of electricity purchased from renewable sources.

Share – A program co-sponsored by Tampa Electric and the Salvation Army where customers can help pay the energy bills of customers in need. A one-time contribution can be made, or your monthly elected contribution will appear on your bill. Your contribution is tax deductible and is matched by Tampa Electric.

Total Amount Due – This month's charges will be past due after the date shown. THIS DATE DOES NOT EXTEND THE DATE ON ANY PREVIOUS BALANCE. It is important that you pay your bill before this date in order to avoid interruption of service.

Zap Cap Systems* – Surge protection for your home or business sold separately as a non-energy charge.

Bright Choicessm—The number of light fixtures and/or poles leased from Tampa Electric, and associated fees and charges.

BTU - British thermal unit - a unit of heat measurement.

Budget Billing – Optional plan takes the highs and lows out of monthly natural gas and electric bills. This "leveling" billing plan averages your last 12 monthly billing periods so you can pay about the same amount for your service each month.

Buried Piping Notification – Federal regulations require that Peoples Gas notify our customers who own buried piping of the following: 1) When excavating near buried gas piping, the piping should be located in advance; 2) The gas supplier does not own or maintain the customer's buried piping; 3) Buried piping that is not maintained may be subject to corrosion and/or leakage. Buried piping should be inspected periodically and any unsafe conditions repaired. Licensed plumbers, heating and air conditioning contractors, or Peoples Gas can conduct inspections.

Conversion Factor – This factor is used to adjust for variations from standard delivery pressure and standard delivery temperature where applicable.

Distribution Charge – Covers the costs of moving gas from its source to your premise, other than the cost of gas itself.

Energy Charge – The cost (except fuel) of producing the electricity you purchased, including conservation, environmental and capacity cost recovery charges.

Estimated – If we were unable to read your meter, "ESTIMATED" will appear. Your use has been estimated based on previous usage. The meter is scheduled to be read next month, and any difference between the estimate and actual use will be adjusted accordingly.

Fiorida Gross Receipts Tax – A tax is imposed on gross receipts from utility services that are delivered to retail customers in Florida, in accordance with Chapter 203 of the Florida Statutes. The tax is levied on utility companies, which collect the tax from all customers, unless exempt, and remit to the state.

Florida State Tax - A privilege tax imposed on every person who engages in the business of selling or renting tangible personal property at retail in the state, in accordance with Chapter 212 of the Florida Statules.

Franchise Fee – A fee levied by a municipality for the right to utilize public property for the purpose of providing natural gas and electric service. Like taxes, the fee is collected by Peoples Gas and Tampa Electric and is paid to the municipality.

Fuel Charge – Cost of fuel used to produce electricity you purchased. Fuel costs are passed through from fuel suppliers to our customers with no markup or profit to Tampa Electric.

Kilowatt-Hours (kWh) – The basic measurement of electric energy use.

Late Payment Charge - For electric past due amounts more than \$10, the late payment charge is the greater of \$5 or 1.5% of the past due amount. For electric past due amounts of \$10 or less, the late payment charge is 1.5% of the past due amount. For natural gas, the late payment charge is 1.5% of the past due amount.

Main Extension Charge - A flat monthly fee to recover the cost of extending mains to a particular area when the cost exceeds the maximum allowable construction cost.

Measured Volume – Your natural gas usage in CCF (one hundred cubic feet) or MCF (one thousand cubic feet). These are the standard units of gas measurement.

Municipal Public Service Tax – In addition to the Franchise Fee, many municipalities levy a tax on the natural gas and electricity you use. It is collected by Peoples Gas and Tampa Electric and paid to the municipality.

PGA Charge - Purchased Gas Adjustment - the cost of gas purchased for you by Peoples Gas and delivered to your premises.

Past Due – Previous charges that are past due are subject to a late payment charge fee and may result in disconnection.

Rate Schedule - The amount (rate) you pay depends on your customer category. The cost of providing service varies with the customer group.

Renewable Energy_{8M} - The amount of electricity purchased from renewable sources.

Share – A program co-sponsored by Peoples Gas and Tampa Electric and the Salvation Army where customers can help pay the energy bills of customers in need. A one-time contribution can be made, or your monthly elected contribution will appear on your bill. Your contribution is tax deductible and is matched by Peoples Gas and Tampa Electric.

Swing Charge - Covers the costs that are incurred by Peoples Gas to balance the difference between a customer's actual daily usage and the gas delivered by your gas supplier (pool manager).

Therm – A unit of heat equal to one hundred thousand (100,000) BTUs.

Total Amount Due - This month's charges will be past due after the date shown. THIS DATE DOES NOT EXTEND THE DATE ON ANY PREVIOUS BALANCE. It is important that you pay your bill before this date in order to avoid interruption of service.

Site #7 was seen with surface filamentous algae and the floating plant, Duckweed (bottom right). This growth requires attention and will be targeted at the next maintenance visit. A nutrient reduction treatment is recommended for the site.

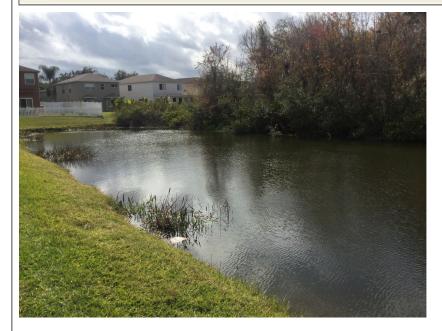






Comments: Normal growth observed

Site #8 (above) was seen in good condition with minimal amounts of nuisance vegetation and minor amounts of surface filamentous algae growth. Site #9 was seen in good condition (top and bottom right).







Comments: Site looks good

Minor amounts of Water Lettuce, Alligator Weed and Cattails were seen in site #10 and will continue to be managed. Vines within the site were pulled by hand during the maintenance visit on 1/24/19 to promoted native Pickerelweed plants.

Management Summary

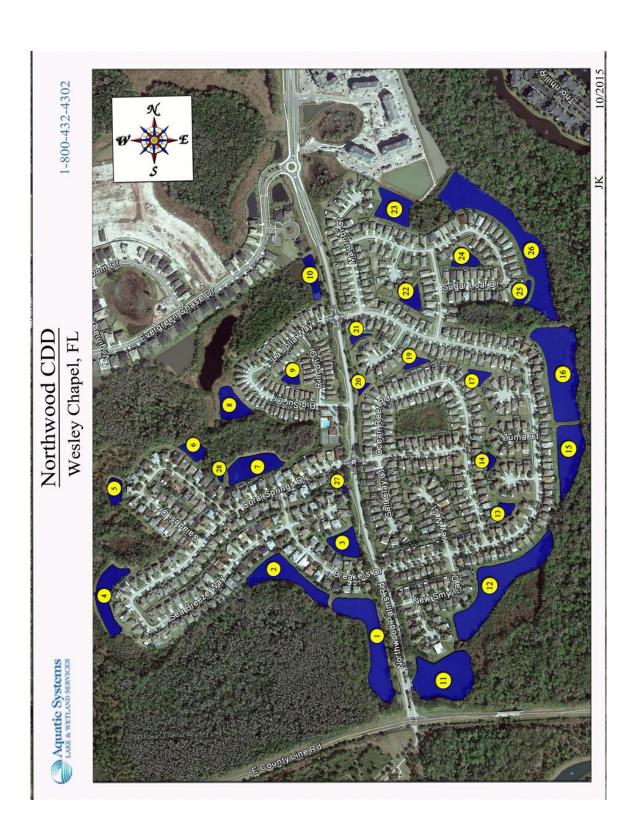
The waterway inspection report for Northwood CDD was performed on February 1st, 2019 for the first ten sites in the community. Filamentous algae growth was seen in sites #4, #5 #6 and #7, all sites which characteristically experience persistent algae growth. Site #6 was seen with normal growth of filamentous algae, concentrated on the shallow littoral area of the site. The solor aeration unit was functioning during the site inspection, and water clarity was high in the pond. A dissolved oxygen profile done in November has shown an increase in dissolved oxygen at the bottom of the site and reduced stratification. Site #6 is recommended for a native plant installation on the littoral shelf and a proposal is forthcoming.

Pond #4 continues to receive algaecide applications for an excess of growth within the site. Applications were applied on 12/14 and 1/11 with results pictured in the waterway inspection report. An aeration installation is highly recommended as a priority site for the community. Site #5 is also a candidate for an aeration unit installation based off of water quality testing results previously done in the site.

Recommendations/Action Items

- Site #4 and #5 are Recommended for an Aeration Unit Installation.
- Sites #5, #6, #7, #8, #12 and #23 are Recommended for a Native Plant Installation on the Littoral Shelf.
- Site #4 is Recommended for a Native Plant Installation Following an Aeration Unit Installation.
