Supervisor Kilpatrick asked for rendering that has a before and after. At the wall next to the clubhouse, the Board agreed to put some red copperleaf and other green plants there. For the benches, Mr. Davidson and the Board directed for LMP to do before and after renderings, have photos of the plant material, and make the benches the same.
