The Board reviewed the management reports. Supervisor Kilpatrick mentioned a section of the sidewalk that consistently has debris and dirt. Supervisor Uhlig said that might have been the area where there was an issue with the drainage. Management will follow up with the landscape maintenance vendor. Supervisor Kilpatrick asked for Mr. Marquez to follow up with the aquatics company about switching out the bulbs. The Board also talked about issues with the wall and cracks along the marquis. They would like to use a map to track which sections have had repairs and which sections need work.

The Board reiterated that they would like to make sure LMP attends the next meeting.

8. SUPERVISOR REQUESTS

Supervisor Cruz said she would like to have a discussion on the phased reopening of the amenities. The Board agreed to discuss. Supervisor Quigley asked about opening up the tennis and basketball courts. Supervisor Cruz asked about following CDC guidelines. Supervisor Quigley noted it would be difficult for the District to enforce on the courts. Supervisor Kilpatrick asked about putting signs up to say that using the courts is at your own risk. The Board discussed liability and what the District's insurance company had advised previously. Mr. Davidson said he can find out more information from Counsel and the insurance company. Supervisor Cruz also asked for Mr. Marquez and Mr. Davison to look into the cost of a non-touch thermometer and a hand sanitizer station. Mr. Marquez asked about people wanting to have meetings with the same socially distanced setup as the Board had today. The Board said they thought that would be okay.

Supervisor Kilpatrick mentioned getting subscriptions to a newspaper and magazine for residents to look at when they are in the clubhouse, to be further discussed at a future meeting. She also asked about the three water meters on the water bills. Mr. Davidson explained.

Audience members commented about the phased reopening of the amenities, issues with the sidewalks, if a homeowner is allowed to maintain an area of land near his home since it does not appear that the CDD is not maintaining it, and the CDD meetings being in person vs. through teleconference.
